Objectives: At the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Perform DNA extraction from marine samples.
- Perform gene-based bacterial identification.
- Use quantitative Polymerase Chain Reaction (qPCR) to carry out bacterial counts.
- Perform Next-Generation Sequencing (NGS) data analysis and community profiling using online tools.

Prerequisites: B.Sc., M.Sc., or Ph.D. in microbiology, environmental or medical science, or related fields.
